Introduction

These scholarships are provided by Christian Broadcasting Association (CBA) annually.

Purpose

The purpose of these Scholarships is to encourage and support young Christians who intend to pursue a career in secular broadcasting or media.

Value and tenure

The value of each Scholarship will be NZ\$4,000

CBA's intention in 2022 is to award three scholarships of this value.

Eligibility

Applicants for the Scholarships must:

1. be New Zealand citizens or have New Zealand permanent residential status.
2. have been accepted for enrolment or be currently enrolled in a broadcasting or media course at a New Zealand tertiary institute.
3. be at least 18 years-of-age and under 35 years-of-age at the time of application.
4. be a bona fide member of a Christian denomination or community.

Referees

CBA requires information from three referees regarding the applicant:

- one of the referees must be the current priest/minister/pastor/or a senior person from the church of the applicant;
- the second must have some academic standing (e.g. a secondary school teacher or university lecturer);
- and the third can be anyone the applicant chooses to reference their character, who has known them for some time, so long as that person is not a blood or family relative of the applicant.
